#### RED CROSS LAY RESPONDER CERTIFICATIONS (2-year certification) —

Participants have two options for completing the above certifications — **traditional in-class** where all components are completed in class or **blended learning** where a portion of the components are online and the hands-on portion is classroom instruction. **Maximum 8 participants for all components.** All participants receive Key-chain Breathing Barrier. INSTRUCTOR: Becky Stabler, Red Cross Licensed Training Provider

#### Adult CPR/AED (Component 1)

In 4 to 6 minutes a person without breath can begin Saturday, Mar experiencing brain damage. Learn how to react when In-Class Component 2: the person needs CPR or is choking. Checking the Saturday, Mar scene and calling for help play a big role in this skill. In-Class Component 3:
